I Corinthians

Chapter 15: Verses 35-44

1 Corinthians 15:3-4 →

**³ For I delivered to you as of first importance
what I also received, that Christ died for our
sins according to the Scriptures,**



1 Corinthians 15:3-4 ←

⁴ and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,



1 Corinthians 15:1-2 →

¹ Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand,



1 Corinthians 15:1-2 ←

² by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain.



1 Corinthians 15:12

Now if Christ is preached, that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?



1 Corinthians 15:16

For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ
has been raised;

But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep.

Ezekiel 37:7-8, 10 →

⁷ So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold, a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to its bone.

⁸ And I looked, and behold, sinews were on them, and flesh grew and skin covered them; but there was no breath in them.

1 Corinthians 15:35

is imperishable and undefiled and will not
fade away, reserved in heaven for you,**



1 Peter 1:3-5 ↔

⁵ who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
